BOARD MEETING

SEPTEMBER 26, 2020 AT 9:30 AM

NCCB Board Meeting called to order at 9:40 am by Paul Furman.

**QUORUM:** Shelley Niehaus stated that a quorum was met.

**MINUTES:** Motion was made to accept minutes of the August 22, 2020 board meeting by J. Craig Lilly. Seconded by Pat Johnson. All approved.

**FINANCIALS:** Pat Johnson presented the financial report. Motion made by Nancy Furman to accept the financials. Seconded by Cindy Hazzard. All approved.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Veteran Coalition: Event and parade cancelled.
2. Music Shed: Cindy Hazzard spoke to Mike Holt about electrical and installing a mini split system. He stated he was not able to do it and suggested an electrician. J. Craig

Lilly is going to speak to Mike Holt again because the shed has electric.

3. Band Rehearsal: Nancy Furman brought the governor's order that everything is okay to be opened. Nancy Furman is going to contact the facilities manger at Lecanto Middle School. Nancy Furman is also going to contact Marty Ball at Citrus Springs. Cornerstone has received their certificate and there is a new pastor and assistant pastor. Nancy Furman will check with the facilities to see when we can get back in.

Nancy Furman will confer with Rock Crusher Church of God if Lecanto Middle School will not let us practice.

J. Craig Lilly will contact the principal at Lecanto Middle School to see when we can use the facilities.

J. Craig Lilly will also contact the three(3) new music teachers to introduce the band and to invite them to join the NCCB.

4. Paul Furman contacted the Rock Crusher Canyon to see if we could use their facilities. The Pavilion is \$1,800.00 and the canyon is \$23,000.00 an event.

A suggestion was made to practice at Citrus Springs but that would cost the band to use the facility.

**WEBSITE:** Nancy Furman stated that we have paid half of the contract agreement to Take Notice web designer of \$670.00. The

new website will go live once we approve it. Nancy Furman will get a potential date when the website will be ready for review.

**GRANT:** Pat Johnson has not applied for any grant money at this time. Pat Johnson stated she is working on finding grants for the band.

**BROCHURE:** Susan Mahoney has brochure ready. Waiting on concert dates.

**DONATION FORM:** Susan Mahoney is working on a donation form for the back of the program.

**VOLUNTEER FORM:** Susan Mahoney presented a volunteer form for the board to approve. Changes to the form were suggested and Susan will make these changes and present new form to Board at next meeting.

Pat Johnson will check liability insurance to make sure all volunteers are covered by insurance.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**SALES TABLE:** Cindy Hazzard stated that the sales table items need to be inventoried. The CD's need to have someone design the covers and decide if we are going to continue with the CD's. The decision was made the CD's will be made available on the web page for the band members to download. We will continue to have CD for purchase for the public.

Nancy Furman will get with Emily Reisdorf and copy all the concerts onto the NCCB laptop. Pat Johnson will give Nancy Furman the programs to also download onto the NCCB laptop.

Pat Johnson and Shelley Niehaus will inventory the sale table items. Pat Johnson and Shelley Niehaus will also take care of the sales table items in the ordering and refilling sales items.

Nancy Furman is going to check with Take Notice to see what promotional items they have available.

Cindy Hazzard stated that Barbara Shook could make t-shirts because Barbara Shook has the machine to make t-shirts.

Susan Mahoney stated as public relations t-shirts are not a good business item.

### **DIRECTOR'S CORNER:**

J. Craig Lilly stated that he would like to have the band wear white bow ties and the woman wear white corsages.

Nancy Furman will order white bow ties. Cindy Hazzard will get the corsage supplies and make a date and we will have a corsage meeting to put together the corsages.

J. Craig Lilly stated that the Kingdom of the Sun will start practicing on October 5, 2020.

J. Craig Lilly stated that Ms. Patricia Bougard that she has instruments for sale from Dr. Terry Bougard. J. Craig Lilly will get a list of these instruments and the prices.

**END OF YEAR PARTY:** Shelley Niehaus suggested we have a meet and greet and end of year party. Nancy Furman is going to check with Georgia Harris about using the bowling alley. The party will have a bowling tournament(4 person team) 9 pin no tap, an ugly Christmas sweater contest and a Christmas cookie contest.
